## Brussels AV Community Activities to Support Industry . . . and a Lacklustre EU Response . . .

### **Brussels Informal AV Coalition Workstreams:**

- Information-sharing/assessment of impact of pandemic across the creative and business ecosystem
- Assessment/feedback into EU economic impact assessment (EAO v. Olsberg/SPI)
- Advocacy activities (Solidarity & Unity Creators and Business)
- COVID-19 Industry Recovery Toolbox (cash flow, insurance, increased costs of doing business, investment stimulus – all across short/medium/long term industry activities)

#### EU Response:

- EU Recovery Fund (general and allocated at Member State level)
- Flexibility in current EU programmes (Creative Europe/MEDIA)
- Deployment of existing programmes (regional funds, research, etc.)

BUT no real focused EU response to elements identified by industry . . .

## The EU Recipe for COVID-19 Recovery

## Increased Access to Content Online . . . Across Borders . . . :

- Review of EU Geo-blocking Regulation in coming years?
- Review of other relevant EU legislation (Portability Regulation, TV & Radio Programmes Directive) and interaction between copyright and competition law

## **Overarching Commission Political Roadmap for Recovery:**

- Resilience
- Environmental sustainability
- Digital transition
