



INDEPENDENT FILMS TAKE HOME 14 WINS AT 95TH ACADEMY AWARDS INCLUDING BEST PICTURE

Los Angeles, CA - March 13, 2023 – Independent films had an incredible night at the 2023 Academy Awards taking home 14 wins accounting for 70% of the awards in 20 of the feature categories, the Independent Film & Television Alliance® (IFTA®) is pleased to announce. Oscar winners ***Everything Everywhere All at Once***, ***The Whale***, ***All Quiet on the Western Front*** and ***RRR*** are all independent having been financed, produced and sold territory-by-territory outside of the major Hollywood studios.

Everything Everywhere All at Once, financed by IFTA Member Huayi Brothers and released by independent A24, swept the awards taking home seven statues.
