

Independent Films Sweep 97th Annual Academy Awards®, Claiming 75% of Feature Film Wins

Los Angeles, CA – March 3, 2025 – At last night's 97th Academy Awards®, independent films demonstrated their artistic excellence and dominated the evening by securing 15 out of the 20 awards in feature film categories. This remarkable achievement accounts for 75% of all feature film wins, the Independent Film & Television Alliance® (IFTA®) is pleased to announce.

This year, eight independent films, distinguished by their financing, production, and territory-by-territory sales outside of the major Hollywood studios, captured Oscars®. Among the notable winners was "Anora," produced by IFTA Member FilmNation Entertainment, which triumphed in five major categories: Best Picture, Directing, Actress in a Leading Role, Writing (Original Screenplay) and Film Editing.

IFTA Member companies, including FilmNation Entertainment, Pathé, Protagonist Pictures, SND Films, STUDIOCANAL, and Wild Bunch, played pivotal roles in the production, financing, sales, and distribution of this year's award-winning films. The independent sector's impressive presence was further highlighted by its 62 nominations at this year's Oscars, underscoring a landmark year for Independents around the globe.
